This is the last day of the Octave of Easter, but the Easter Season will accompany us until the night of Pentecost on May 23. It was such a pleasure and privilege to celebrate Holy Week and the Paschal Triduum with all of you, in person or via zoom, and to welcome two brand-new Catholics into our Catholic Church during the Easter Vigil Mass: Bill and Quinn. Bill chose his birth name (**St. William**) for baptism, and Quinn chose the famous Belgian priest (**St. Damien of Moloka'i**), as they received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist on April 3.

In spite of the pandemic restrictions, we were able to have a lovely celebration of our high holy days, made all the more beautiful by countless volunteers and staff members who pitched in to make sure all was ready and festive. My warmest thanks to all who make this parish community strong and loving through your prayer, care, and outreach!

We are also blessed to have generous people in this parish who are helping us move toward our Annual Appeal goal for 2021. **As of March 27, we had received \$32,330 toward our goal of \$76,246.** Clearly, we will need more good people to please step up to the plate: each year I give \$1,000 to the AAA and encourage parishioners to match or exceed my gift if their circumstances permit. Thanks be to God, we have a good number of parish members using the e-giving page on our parish website to support Saint Anselm's so we can continue to be strong, and to stay in the black.

If you were not able to attend Mass on Easter Sunday because the pandemic restrictions were full, please remember that the season lasts fifty days, and so you have plenty of time to take part in Easter right here in your spiritual home.

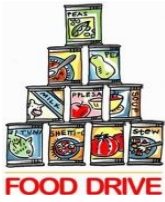
